On September 10, 2010 at about 7:36 P.M. Redding Police Department Officers responded to the Safeway located at 1070 E. Cypress in Redding, CA. for a report of an attempted robbery. During the course of the investigation it was learned that an unknown black male adult and an unknown white female adult entered Safeway and the male was later observed concealing a 750 ML bottle of Rum in his t-shirt. The male then attempted to exit the store with the concealed bottle of Rum. Loss Prevention Officer Jesse Fisher, 50 years of age of Cottonwood, CA. attempted to stop the male and female from exiting the store by blocking the exit. When Fisher attempted to detain the male and female, the male struck Fisher with the bottle of alcohol in the left temple area. As a result of being struck with the bottle, Fisher may have briefly lost consciousness, while the male and female fled the business on foot towards Churn Creek Rd and Cypress Ave. Fisher refused medical treatment at the scene. An area check was conducted with negative results.

The male was further described as being in his early twenties, about 6'0" tall, weighing about 180 pounds, with very short hair. The female was further described as being in her late teens to early twenties, about 5'2" tall, weighing about 110 pounds with blonde hair. A photograph of the suspects is available upon request.
